than two thousand local affiliates throughout the nation, points out that all forms of RD - illnesses - have a relationship to tuberculosis. Chronic respiratory diseases include not only TB and emphysema, but such serious ailments as pleurisy, chronic bronchitis, asthma, lung cancer, and certain fungal infections of the lungs.

In addition, acute respiratory diseases such as influenza and pneumonia, while less dangerous in themselves than in former times, can break down resistance and help inactive tuberculosis germs cause active disease.

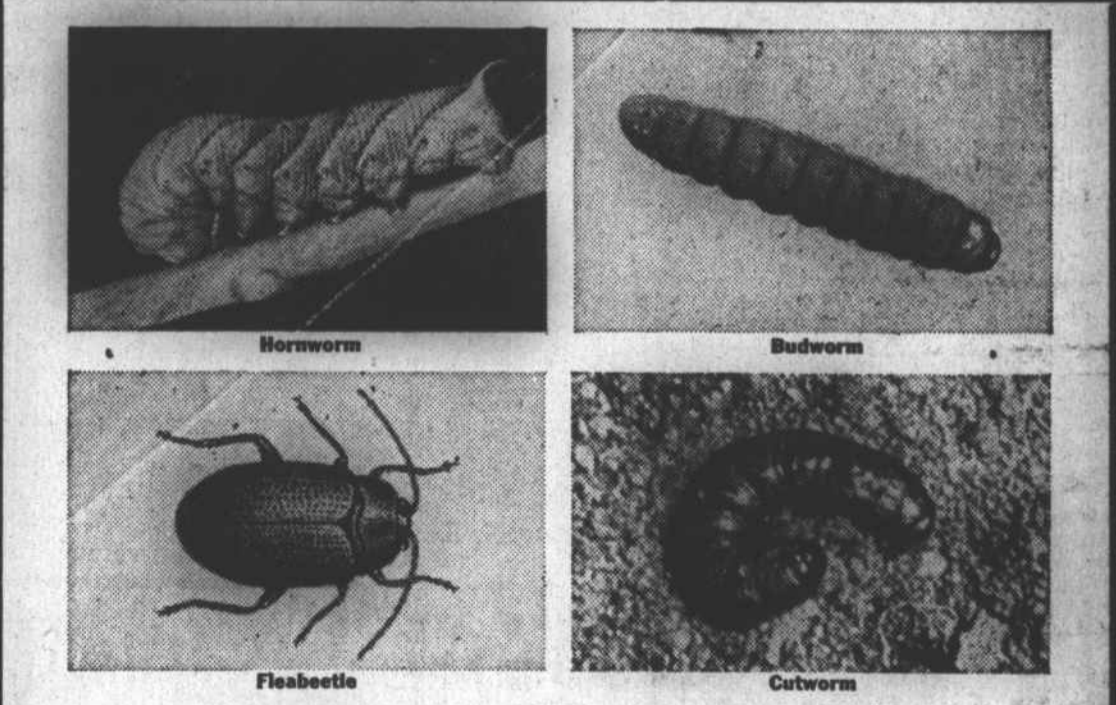
