ORDER AUTHORIZING \$64,000 REFUNDING BONDS
BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED BY the Board of Commissioners for the County of Duplin:

1. That bonds of the County of Duplin, North Carolina, shall be issued, pursuant to The County Finance Act, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$64,000 for the purpose of refunding a like amount of the principal of valid subsisting bonded indebtedness of said County which was originally incurred before January 1, 1929 for the construction of roads and bridges in said County and is evidenced by the following:

\$14,000 Refunding Road and Bridge Bonds, dated June 1, 1946, maturing June 1, 1964.
\$19,000 Refunding Road and Bridge Bonds, dated December 1, 1947, maturing June 1, 1964.
\$6,000 Refunding Road and Bridge Bonds, dated August 1, 1948, maturing February 1, 1964, and
\$10,000 Refunding Road and Bridge Bonds, dated December 1, 1952, maturing June 1, 1964.

2. That bonds of the County of Duplin, North Carolina, shall be issued, pursuant to the County Finance Act, as amended, in an amount not exceeding \$15,000 for the purpose of refunding a like amount of the principal of valid subsisting bonded indebtedness of said County which was originally incurred by the Board of Commissioners (as an administrative agent of the State in providing a State system of public schools) for maintaining the constitutional six months' school term and is evidenced by the following:

\$5,000 School Building Bonds, dated June 1, 1946, maturing June 1, 1964.
\$3,000 Refunding School Bonds, dated June 1, 1946, maturing June 1, 1964.
\$3,000 Refunding School Bonds, dated December 1, 1947, maturing June 1, 1964, and
\$4,000 Refunding School Bonds, dated December 1, 1952, maturing June 1, 1964.

3. That a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and the interest on the \$64,000 bonds herein authorized, when due, shall be annually levied and collected.

4. That the holders of the \$64,000 bonds herein authorized shall be subrogated to all the rights and powers of the holders of the indebtedness refunded thereby.

5. That a statement of the County debt has been filed with the clerk and is open to public inspection.

6. That this order shall take effect upon its passage and shall not be submitted to the voters.

The foregoing order was finally passed on the 7th day of October, 1963, and was first published on the 10th day of October, 1963.
