USS AGERHOLM, June 28 - Engineman Second Class James C. Godbold, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles L. Godbold, Route 3, Faison, N.C., is serving aboard the USS Agerholm. The destroyer Agerholm recently celebrated her 20th birthday while operating in the South China Sea, as a unit of the Seventh Fleet.

The Agerholm was commissioned on June 20, 1946, at the Bath Iron Works, Bath, Maine. She was named for Private First Class Harold C. Agerholm, U. S. Marine Corps Reserve from Racine, Wis., who was killed in action in the assault on Saipan during the second World War.

MARION C. PARKER

USCGC (WAGC-281) June 30 - Chief Damage Controlman Marion C. Parker, USCG, son of Mr. and Mrs. Herbert Parker of Route 2, Rose Hill, N.C., served on the Royal Arctic Court of King Neptune aboard the Coast Guard icebreaker Westwind as the cutter's Bluesoes, men not previously received by the King, were brought forward for their initiation into the Royal Order of Polar Bears.

The traditional ceremony was held as the Brooklyn, N. Y., based cutter sailed through the arctic Circle near Sondre Stromfjord, Greenland.

Prior to being received by King Neptune each Bluesoe was prepared by the Royal Painter and Royal Barber.

The Westwind is operating as a unit of Commander, Task Force 8, a military sea transportation service command responsible for the supplying of many isolated northern bases in the Arctic Region.

SAUERKRAUT RELISH
