

For the antique lover, to-day's king-size beds offer dramatic decorating possibilities. They are available with sturdy frames which do not require headboards or footboards. This gives you many opportunities for individualized draping or custom headboard treatments.

One decorator pushed a king-size bed against the wall, installed a brass hook such as those used for hanging lamps,

Another bedroom decorator achieved a four-poster effect by hanging draperies from the ceiling at each corner of the king-size bed, gathering them with standard drapery department rosettes.


