sail Island from which anglers snare blues, spots, trout, flounder, Spanish mackerel, pompano, tarpon, cobia and Virginia mullets.

Contests are staged annually for the biggest fish caught, and is sponsored by the Topsail Island Fishing Club. Any potential winner may have his catch registered at any of the official weighing stations. A Banquet is held in December for winners, who are notified by mail prior to the banquet. Outside fishing is quite popular at Topsail and fishermen from boats catch amberjacks, pigfish, black drum, dolphin, channel bass pompano, red snapper and many other varieties. Intercoastal waterway provides an abundance of blues, trout, spots, and flounder.
