# Warsaw Little League Playing Season Opens Sat.

The playing season for the Warsaw Little League will open Saturday preceded by a flag-raising ceremony, singing the national anthem and the mayor throwing out the first ball. The program will get underway at 1:30 P.M. with all teams and their coaches on the field.

At 2 P.M. the first game will get underway with the American Legion and the Rotary teams competing. At approximately 4 P.M. the second game will be played with the National Spinning and the Jaycee teams competing. The public is cordially invited to observe these ceremonies and games at the Junior High playing field.

For the four Saturdays preceding the closing of school games will be played Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, 3:30-5:30 P.M. Coaches and players are asked to be on

the field well before time for the game in order to have the "warm ups" before time for the game. In this way the game can start promptly.

Prospective players for the five teams are reminded that the draft for these teams will remain open through May. Any boy who will attain the age of 9 years before August 1 and who will not attain the age of 13 before August 1 is eligible to play. Any boy of the proper age who desires to play should come to the field any Saturday in May before two o'clock to present himself for possible selection as a player on one of the teams. prevents him from paying this fee can still play as other arrangements will be made for his fee.

Approximately forty-four games will be played during the season. The season will close the latter part of July.
