



ESCE ANNOUNCES Public Service Employment

By: Charles M. Ingram Mrs. Elizabith H. Grant Manager of the Kenansville Office of the North Carolina Employment Security Com-mission, announced this week that a program to provide Pu-blic Service Employment (PSE) has been funded. PSE program is intended to provide incentives to government agencies and nonpr organizations to train and hire personnel. These personnel will be recruited from the re-cipeints of Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) through the Work Incentive Program (win), which is jointly sponsored by the Federal Government and the

North Carolina State Government, Under the PSE program an agency or organization may be reimbursed for 100% of the trainee's salary and fringe benefits during the training period, which may be from eight weeks to twelve months, depending upon the skill level of the occupation. The trainees are hired under the same conditions as all other employess hired by the employer. Trainees will receive the minimum starting wage rate as the normal entry wage. An agreement between the employer and the Employment Security Commission will identify the training occupation and training period. The job should meet an un-

provided public service need. The employer's obligations consist of hiring and training the employee, providing adequate supervision, maintaining and attendance records. submitting monthly invoice for reimbursement, and continuing the employment upon successful completion of the training. The employers' sole cost is the cost of supervision. Employers' benefits consist of contract reimbursement of trainee's salary and fringe benefits during training period, the satisfaction of assisting a disadvantaged person become a taxpayer, and the contribution to community social betterment.

Mrs. Grant stated that any interested employers can obtain additional information by contacting the Employment Security Commission Office, located in the Old Welfare Building, on Seminary Street, in Kenansville. The telephone number is 296-4791.
