1977, at 7:30 P.M. at the Courthouse in Kenansville, North Carolina, for the purpose of considering the adoption of a Town Ordinance, under N.C. General Statute 160A-203, to allow the Town of Kenansville to extend the territorial limits of the Town for the purpose of zoning, and subordinate regulations for the hereinafter described property outside the present Town Limits:

Located in Kenansville Township, Duplin County, State of North Carolina, and being described as follows: BEGINNING at a stake in the center of N.C. Highway No. 24 (Also N.C. Highway No. 50) (said stake being located 5,280 feet west as measured along the center line of said highway from a stake in the center of a 46-inch steel culvert in the run of Mill Branch, the town limits of Kenansville) and runs thence 1. North 35 degrees 15 minutes East 8,270 feet to a stake in the center of S.R. No. 1301 (said stake being located 5,280 feet north as measured along the centerline of said road from the center of a concrete bridge over the run of Grove Swamp, the town limits of Kenansville); thence 2. North 70 degrees 20 minutes East, 6,150 feet to a stake in the center of S.R. No. 1378 (said stake being located 5,280 feet north as measured along the centerline of N.C. Highway No. 11 and S.R. No. 1378 from the center of a concrete bridge over the run of Grove Swamp, the town limits of Kenansville); thence 3. South 65 degrees 30 minutes East 6,570 feet to a stake in the center of N.C. Highway No. 11 (said stake being located 5,280 feet northeast as measured along the centerline of said highway from the center of a concrete bridge over the run of Grove Swamp, the town limits of Kenansville); thence 4. South 31 degrees 30 minutes East 7,040 feet to a stake in the centerline of N.C. Highway No. 24 (said stake being located South 68 degrees East 1400 feet from a stake in the centerline intersection of N.C. Highway No. 24 and S.R. No. 1959); thence 5. degrees 30 minutes East 1400 feet from a stake in the centerline intersection of S.R. No. 1959 and N.C. Highway No. 24) thence 6. South 41 degrees 30 minutes West 7,180 feet to a stake in the centerline of N.C. Highway No. 50 (said stake being located North 28 degrees 30 minutes West 430 feet from a stake in the centerline intersection of N.C. Highway No. 50 and S.R. No. 1959); thence 7. South 80 degrees 10 minutes West 10,520 feet to a stake in the centerline of N.C. Highway No. 11 and S.R. No. 1003; thence 8. North 30 degrees 10 minutes West 2,140 feet to a stake in the centerline of S.R. No. 1003 (said stake being located North 72 degrees 45 minutes West 1405 feet from a stake in the centerline intersection of S.R. No. 1003 and N.C. Highway No. 11); thence 9. North 15 degrees 50 minutes West 7,820 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 4,960 acres, more or less. RABIES CONTROL

DOG VACCINATION CLINICS SCHEDULE

The Duplin County Health Department in its continuing effort to keep Duplin County free of rabies, will hold the annual dog vaccination clinics as listed below.

The following three categories of dogs are due vaccinations this year. (1) All unvaccinated dogs four months old or older (2) All dogs vaccinated in 1976 that are wearing silver tags. (3) All dogs vaccinated in 1974 that are wearing red tags.

The vaccine used is the most modern advancement in vaccine development and will be administered by licensed Doctors of Veterinary Medicine.

The General Statutes of North Carolina require that the dog be vaccinated and that they display the vaccination tag at all times. This tag can also be used to identify your dog if lost or strayed. Please take your dog to the clinic nearest your home for this vaccination.
