

New Bookmobile Stop

Beginning Tuesday, Jan. 13, the Duplin County - Dorothy Wightman Library will add a new location to its monthly schedule of bookmobile stops. Residents in the Outlaw's Bridge - Seven Springs - Albertson area may borrow books, records and other materials from the bookmobile between 10 and 10:30 a.m. at Outlaw's Bridge Universalist Church. The Library is adding this stop at the request of citizens in the community.

Robert Williams, library director, asks that anyone interested in obtaining bookmobile service in other areas of the county where it is not presently available, contact her at the library in Kenansville, at 296-1333. The staff is presently evaluating the bookmobile schedule and is interested in expanding service to as many locations as possible. The bookmobile presently makes 28 monthly stops at various locations in Duplin County.


