The members collect magazines and other reading material and distribute to the patients and waiting rooms. Altogether they give an average of 250 hours per month.

The Game Tournament is a fund-raising project. The Auxiliary will use the proceeds to purchase equipment for the hospital. In the two years of existence, this group of volunteers has purchased equipment for two departments. For the operating room, a Vac Pac (Positioning Pads) was bought. Recently

the inhalation therapy department asked the Auxiliary for scanners to be used by the therapists. Two were purchased.

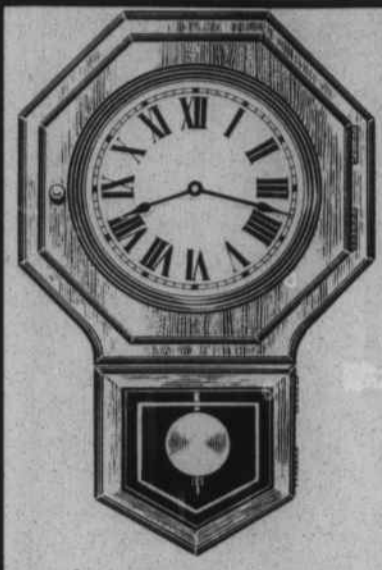
