

Low Income Energy Program

The low income energy program to help with heating bills of low income households will begin Oct. 15. Applications will be taken and processed at the cheese distribution warehouse near the dog pound on Highway 11, south of Kenansville. Social Services staff will be available to take applications from Oct. 15 through Nov. 30 at the warehouse.

This is not a first-come, firstserved program. Anyone applying who meets the eligibility requirements will receive a payment.

There will be no issuance of food items from the warehouse Oct. 15 -Nov. 2. New households wishing to apply for food should not come during that time.

Persons wishing to see Mrs. Betty Broadhead, Social Security representative on Tuesdays will not need to wait in line with the energy applicants.

Income of recipients of food stamps, AFDC, Medicaid and SSI will be used and other applicants will need to verify the total family income for the month of October, 1984.
