The auction will also serve as drawing time for a queen-size strawberry design quilt made by Jean Grady, two \$100 bills, and a male and female bicycle. Admission to the fall festival is 25 cents. 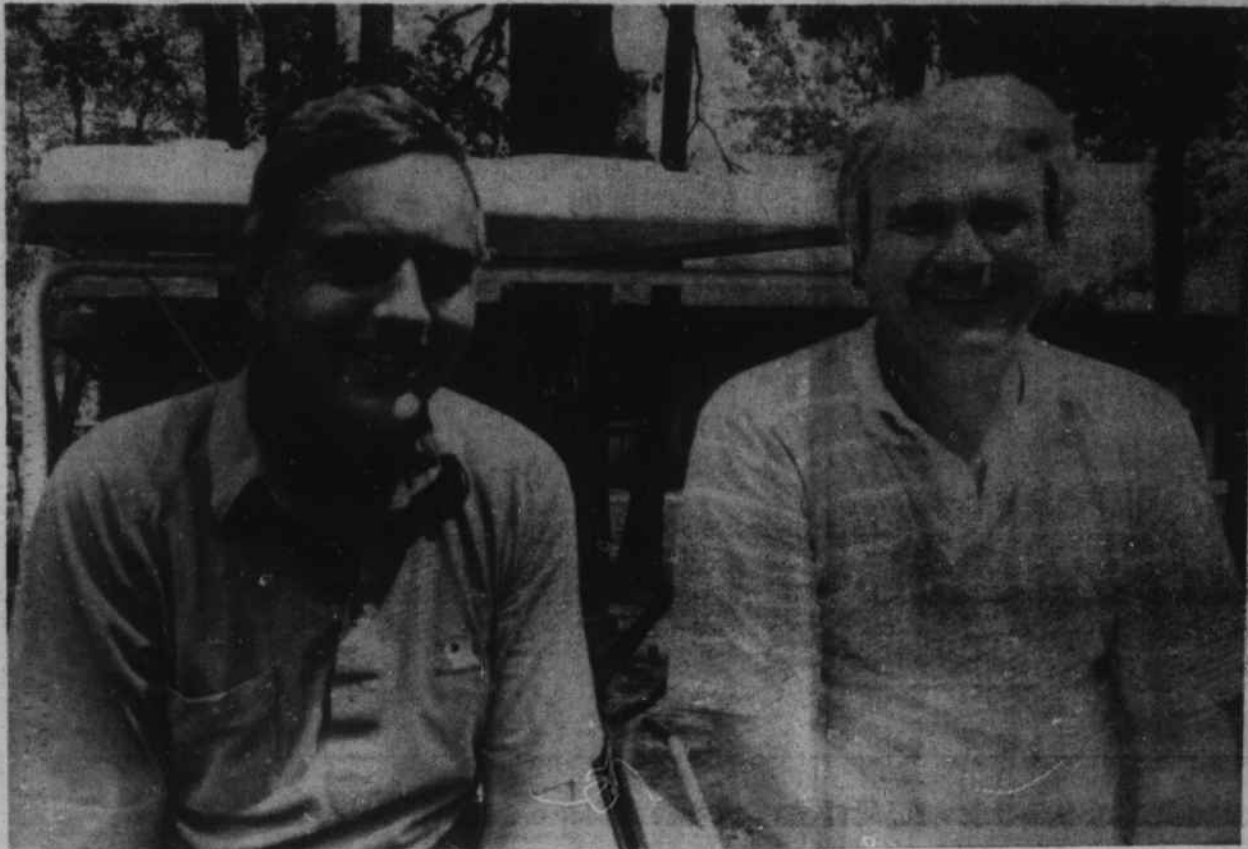
