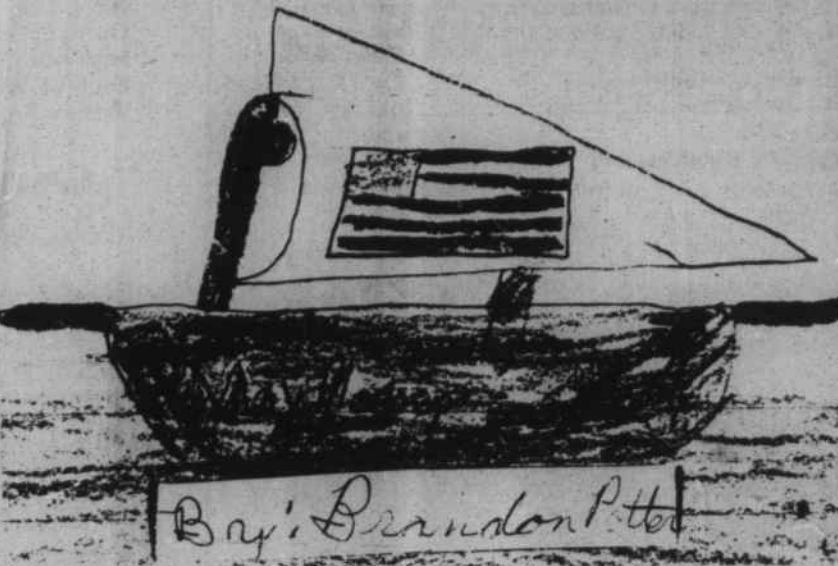
What Thanksgiving Means To Me
