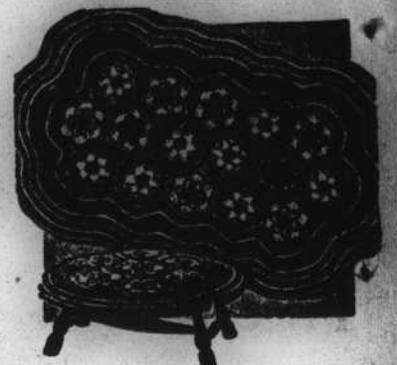

Easy, six-sided medallions are done one by one, each flower a different color with background uniform or not, as you please. Sew them together and you're ready to begin the border crocheting, going round and round with stripes of color used to break the background. Rug wool, rags or candlewicking may be used.

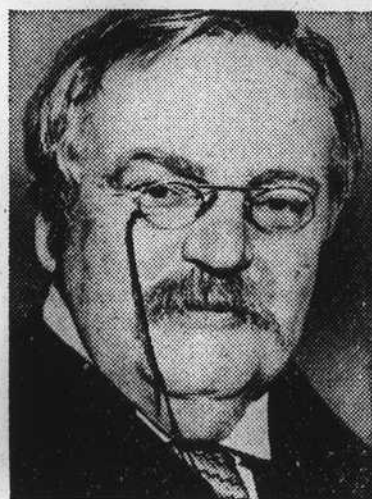

### Coeds Indulge in Rough Sport



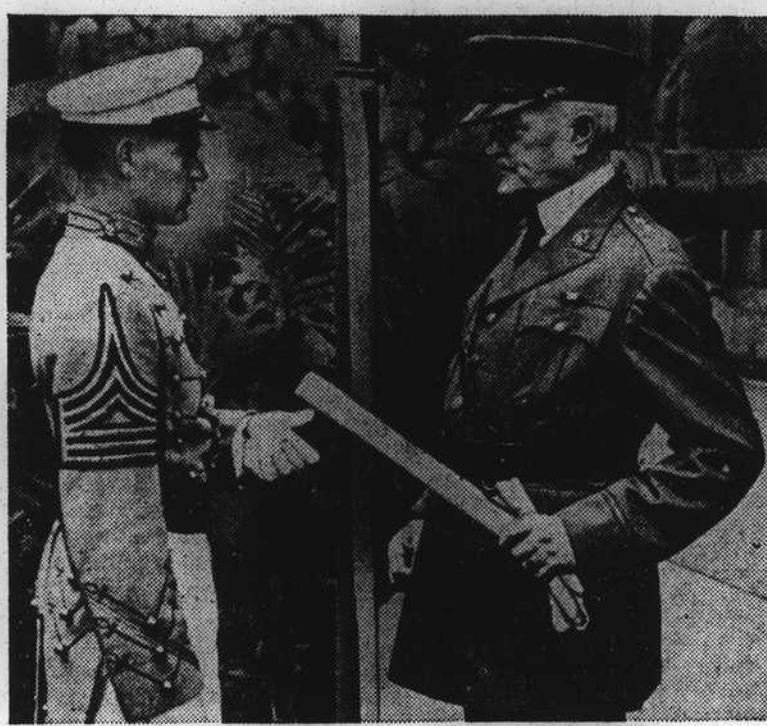

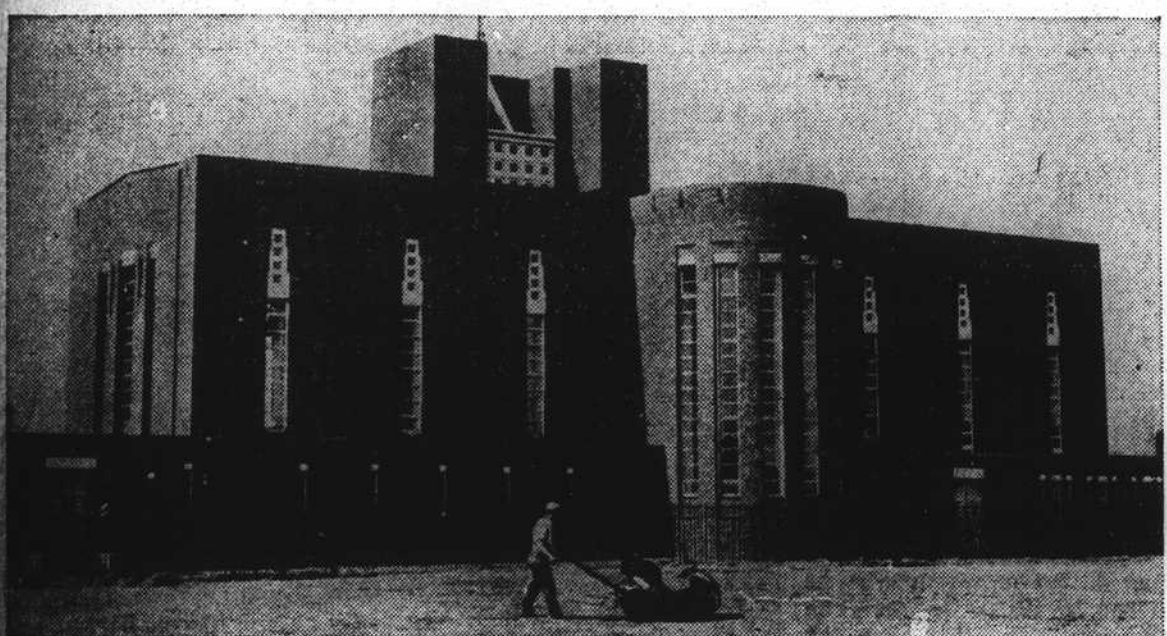
### Henry Verdell of Minneapolis Is Chief of Bankers
