Industrialization of a country predominantly rural, the education of the masses—these are some of the tremendous problems confronting India's leaders. As a consequence, the Christian church faces opportunities unparalleled in her history in India. Her whole service is to help produce a leadership worthy of these great tasks, and to undergird the whole movement with the spirit of Christ. There is truly a race on in India between Christ and communism. Many of the acts of violence which have occurred recently in India can be traced to the influence of those who work under the banner of the hammer and sickle. It is the duty of the Christian church to challenge India's workers to adopt the banner of Christ as their insignia. We at Leonard Theological College are grateful for the privilege of training Christian leaders for the new India.

"The Word of Power for the Pious Age," with special emphasis on "spiritual pioneers," is the theme of the daily Bible readings recommended by the American Bible Society in this year's worldwide scripture reading period from Thanksgiving Day to Christmas Day. Last year

people of 20 different nations (perhaps 20,000,000 individuals) participated in the daily readings, and it is believed the numbers will be greater this year. "Patience toward Russia without appeasement" is the admonition given to America by Dr. Ralph W. Sockman, of Christ Church, New York City, recently returned from a visit to Russia as head of the American Society for Russian Relief. "In our efforts to get a better understanding of Russia we feel baffled by the iron curtain," he says. "On their side, they claim to be thwarted by our misrepresentation of their facts... America claims to be a Christian nation. Now is the time to show it in our relations with a nation which became disillusioned with a certain form of perverted Christianity. To be Christian, America does not need to acquiesce softly to Russia's acquisitive demands. But America to be Christian must bend every effort to sustain the godly idea of one world through strengthening the United Nations lest we drift into the devilish idea of two worlds. And let every American who calls himself a Christian turn a deaf ear to the whisper that now is the time to start dropping atomic bombs on Russia because war is inevitable. If
