SHELLFISH RULES

Rule No. 109 - Section II Amend) Each packer, shucker, canner or other purchaser for resale of oysters shall first obtain a license for which he shall pay the sum of Twenty-Five (\$25.00) each, and shall cause to be delivered for planting on the oyster beds of the State at least one-half of the oyster shells so taken, delivery to be at the direction of the Commissioner of Fisheries or his

Rule No. 109-Section IX It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to unload ovsters from any boat or vessel after sunset or before sunrise.
