Rent Director Answers Queries
 (These questions were selected from those often asked of the local rent office. If you will supply the area rent office with additional information, particularly the address of the unit, we will advise both you and your landlord what, if any, security deposit may be collected.)

Q: My landlord has been charging me more than the legal rent and I have been afraid to complain about it until I got another place to live. Now I am moving and would like to know if I can still do anything about the amount he has overcharged.
A: Yes, you can. The fact that you are moving, or have already moved, does not bar you from bringing suit for three times the overcharge for the year before your suit is filed or for \$50, whichever is greater, plus reasonable attorney's fees and court costs. Incidentally, your landlord could not legally have evicted you because of your complaint.

Q: I was talking with a friend of mine about the housing shortage here and I told him that I had a large house I would be willing to have made into apartments if I was sure it was worth the trouble. He said he thought you people at the rent office had some kind of provision to assure people who make such conversions a fair return. Would you explain to me any such provisions in your program?
A: To encourage owners of large homes to convert them for multiple family occupancy, the Office of Rent Stabilization will give a prior opinion before work is begun, stating the maximum rent ceiling which will be established for the proposed accommodations. This maximum rent will be in the amount generally prevailing in the area for comparable rental units. When you get the opinion you can tell whether you wish to make the conversion.

Q: My landlord, from whom I've been renting for several years, told me last week that beginning on the first of next month I'd have to pay five dollars extra each month but that I'd get this money back when I move if I have not damaged the property and have paid the rent when it came due. I have never hurt the property and always pay my rent promptly. I resent having to pay the \$5 extra and want to know what I can do about it.
A: Your landlord is apparently intending to charge you what is known as a "security deposit" each month. The rent laws do allow landlords to collect such deposits under some circumstances but it
