Whereas, on or about the 6th day of October, 1952, the Board of Town Commissioners of the Town of Beaufort, North Carolina, received a petition, from a large portion of the residents of the area described below, requesting that the area described be annexed to the Town of Beaufort and;

Whereas in accordance with G.S. 160-445 it is necessary for the Board to conduct a public hearing after due public notice as is required by G.S. 160-445.

Now therefore be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Beaufort:

That the public will take notice that the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Beaufort, N. C., will on the 30th day of December, 1952, in the Town Hall at 7:30 P.M. EST, conduct a public hearing on the question as to whether or not the following described area shall be annexed to the Town of Beaufort.
