The bay on which the new hos-pital and motel are located bears the name of the early settlers, Nel-son's Bay.

Among the old families at Sea Level are the Luptons and the Styrons. Tales handed down from one family to the next say that three Luptons came across from England — one settled on Hog Island, one on Cedar Island, and one at Sea Level.

There are also Gaskills, Taylors and Salters at Sea Level. The Gas-kills are believed to have migrated southward from Bath, a little town in Beaufort County which is one of the oldest in the United States.
