COMMERCIAL FISHERIES REGULATIONS
 The following regulations were adopted at the October 19-20, 1953, meeting of the Board of Conservation and Development, under and in accordance with the regulatory powers vested by Chapter 113, Sections 135 and 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina in said Board. These regulations have been filed with the Secretary of State of North Carolina, certified copies dispatched by registered mail to the Clerks of the Superior Court of the twenty-one counties having commercial fishing waters and advertised once a week for four weeks as provided by law.

Any violation of these regulations under the provisions of law constitutes a misdemeanor.
NEW REGULATION
 Fish-Food

"Regulation No. 115: It shall be unlawful to set pound nets in the middle third of Albemarle Sound beginning at a line drawn from Caroon Point to the west point of Collington Island known as Rodham's and extending throughout the Sound, in a general northwesterly and westerly direction, except that this shall not prohibit the use of pound nets in the areas set aside for such fishing covered by Rules 98 and Rules 100 of the Rules and Regulations of the North Carolina Commercial Fisheries."

AMENDED REGULATION
 Fish-Food
 "Regulation No. 84—(20): It shall be lawful to set pound nets inside the following boundaries, beginning at a stake 2,000 yards from the shore southeast 1/4 south from Long Shoal Point and running 2,000 yards from the shore at the outside points with the curve of the mainland to the 2 1/2 mile radius 2,000 yards from the shore south of Roanoke Marshes; thence north-northeast a straight line 3,700 yards to a stake 700 yards south-southwest from Roanoke Marshes Light; thence north 1/4 west 600 yards to a stake 300 yards west from Roanoke Marshes Light; thence a straight line north by west 1/4 west 9,800 yards to a stake 1/5th the width of the sound at Fleetwood Point; thence a straight line northwest by north 1/4 north 8,000 yards to the Red Spar Buoy No. 4 a south westerly course from Croatan Light; thence to the Red Can Buoy off Caroo's Point; thence North-west by North 1/4 North 1,150 yards to a point 1,450 yards from the shore; thence northwest by North 1/4 North to a stake 2,100 yards from the shore; thence to a stake 2,250 yards from the shore at what is known as the Claude Midgett Set; thence 2,250 yards from all the outside points with the curve of the shore to a stake 2,250 yards Northwest from Sound Point."
