Lime Coconut Fruit Mold

Ingredients: 2 packages lime-flavored gelatin, 2 cups very hot water, 1 cup cold water, 1 cup or-ange juice, 2 oranges, 20 pitted dates, 1½ cups shredded coco-nut, cream, toasted coconut.

Method: Add celetin to very hot.
