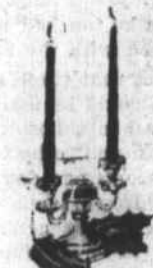

Gisele MacKenzie Turns Singer after Violin Theft

New York — The day I saw Miss Gisele MacKenzie I was covered with dogs — three dachshunds — and she had problems of her own. She had just come from a recording session at Capitol studios and the night before she had warbled on her radio program.

"Most of my songs are composed especially for me," she said, "and this was a song which I particularly liked. I recorded it for Capitol and then sang it on my broadcast that night."

"Immediately I was told that it was a nice song but not to sing it again. The name of the song? 'Get It While You're Young.'"

"I also sing one called 'Waters Can't Quench the Fires of Love' but the networks didn't ban that."

Miss MacKenzie is a lovely brunette except when her tresses are mixed up with dachshund hair. She is a French-Scotch-Canadian singer who has been delighting audiences in the Cotillion Room of the Hotel Pierre.

Continuing her preoccupation with dogs which she uses in that horrible but persistent number "Doggie in the Window," she said she was worried about taking them to California.

"I am going to the west coast to sing with Jack Benny," she said, "and I understand that there isn't much money in working with Mr. Benny. I don't know yet but it should be a lot of fun."

"Mr. Benny said he could fix it for me to sing a duet with Bing Crosby, and that I would do for nothing. Or, almost nothing."

Miss MacKenzie became a singer because she was a concert violinist whose violin was stolen and wouldn't play any other. She had a \$2,000 Ceruti violin which was stolen in Toronto; it was never recovered.
