Questions concerning eligibility rules of the County Dress Revue are being asked each day. The following rules and regulations will be observed in the 4-H Dress Revue this year.

1. Senior girls will not compete against junior girls. There will be two separate divisions.
2. A girl, in order to be declared county winner must be 14 years old as of Jan. 1 of this year.
3. Only 4-H members who are currently and actively participating in Carteret County Clubs are eligible to compete in the Dress Revue.
4. Any commercial pattern can be used for the Dress Revue ensemble.
5. Dresses made in home economics classes are NOT eligible.
6. A lined tailored wool suit is not acceptable. A coat or cape can have a lining if the lining is a part of the general effect of the garment. Example: polka dot blouse, and coat lined in polka dot.
7. The County Dress Revue winner must plan to attend State 4-H Week in Raleigh, July 19-24.
8. The county winner must model the same dress in the State Dress Revue that she modeled in the County Dress Revue. She may make improvements.

There are several projects that 4-H members can carry out that everyone may not know about. One of these projects is a broiler project. The project could work like this: buy 25, 50, or 100 Hampshire cockerels (roosters) and brood 'til the chickens are 8-10 weeks of age, then kill and store in a home freezer or sell at 2 1/2 to 3 pounds.
