COMMERCIAL FISHERIES REGULATION

The following regulation was adopted at the March 25-27, 1954, meeting of the Board of Conservation and Development, under and in accordance with the regulatory powers vested by Chapter 113, Sections 135 and 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina in said Board. This regulation has been filed with the Secretary of State of North Carolina, certified copies dispatched by registered mail to the Clerks of the Superior Court of the twenty-one counties having commercial fishing waters and advertised once a week for four weeks as provided by law.

Any violation of this regulation under the provisions of law constitutes a misdemeanor.

SUBSTITUTE REGULATION—(OPERATION OF TRAWLERS IN INLAND WATERS) SHRIMP

"Regulation No. 7—(175): Any person, firm or corporation, other than a common carrier, who takes out of the State of North Carolina in any trawler or other vessel owned by a non-resident any shrimp taken in the inland commercial waters of the State shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished according to the law, and all shrimp so taken shall be confiscated by the Assistant Commissioner of Commercial Fisheries and either sold by him or otherwise disposed of in his discretion in the best interests of the State of North Carolina and any proceeds realized from such disposition shall be paid into the Commercial Fisheries fund for disposition as other sums of said fund; provided, however, that all trawlers or other vessels owned by a non-resident may have the same shrimp-privileges as those permitted to resident shrimpers of the State if they comply with terms as stated above and if they pay the usual license fees and taxes imposed on residents by the regulations and the laws for the conduct of commercial fishing.

The above privileges shall not be extended to any non-resident shrimper seeking to operate in the inland commercial waters of North Carolina if the State of which he is a resident and in which his trawler or other boat is registered prohibits North Carolina shrimpers or trawlers from operating in the inland waters of that State.

For the purpose of this regulation, the inland commercial waters of North Carolina are hereby defined as those sounds which are separated from the Atlantic Ocean by bodies of land and to which access from said ocean is possible only through inlets or channels; and all rivers emptying directly into the Atlantic Ocean up to the present commercial fishing line, and beginning at the mouth or bar of such river."

ALL OTHER REGULATIONS IN CONFLICT WITH THE ABOVE ACTION ARE REVOKED.
