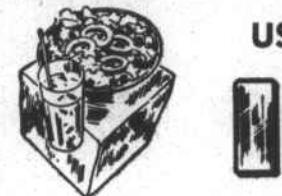
Reporter Finds Famous Recipe Serves 2,000
