Opening before a capacity audience in Mountainside Theatre here, this great true story of the Cherokee Indian's effort to find peace with the white man come to life on historic ground among descendants of the very recoile who were dants of the very people who were

"Unto These Hills" runs nightly except Monday, through Sept. 6. There will be a special Monday night performance Sept. 6.

The production, written by Kermit Hunter and directed by Harry Davis, appears destined to be the best since its opening in 1950 in which it has played to more than half a million persons.
