## Highway Officials Hear Protests on New Road

Protests were voiced Thursday at New Bern by Craven County residents opposed to the routing of a proposed four-lane highway between New Bern and Cherry Point. Conducting the hearings were Highway Commissioners Emmett Winslow of Hertford, M. E. Robinson of Goldsboro, and C. A. Hasty of Maxton. J. E. Tucker and Henry Whitehurst of New Bern, attorneys, represented the opposition. Tucker and Whitehurst told commissioners that their clients were anxious to see the road built, but were not pleased with parts of the proposed location. The new dual highway will carry U. S. Highway 70 from James City, just south of New Bern, from a new Trent River bridge now under construction to a point at Havelock. The highway will follow the present road for most of its route. New bridge work began last September. Governor Comments The project was discussed earlier last week by Governor W. B. Umstead while attending a meeting of the State Board of Conservation and Development at Morehead City. "I hope," Governor Umstead said, "that Route 70 from New Bern to Havelock and Cherry Point can be four-laned as soon as possible. It is the most sorely needed highway in the state." The existing road is considered dangerous and inadequate. It is the main traffic artery serving Cherry Point, the world's largest Marine Air Base, and also is heavily traveled by tourists and beachgoers. W. H. Rogers Jr., State High Engineer told those at the hearing that construction of the new road is the "number one project" now under study by the State Highway Commission. "We cannot compromise and expect federal aid," he said. He pointed out that it would not be practical to widen the present road, although part of the paving will be used as one lane of the new road. "We cannot widen the present

road and just continue killing folks traveling back and forth from Cherry Point to New Bern. We've got to build for the future. Our big mistake in the past has been building roads that were quickly outgrown. This highway will provide room for five or ten times the present traffic, and is the finest that engineering and scientific technique can develop. It will serve for a long time," said Mr. Rogers. No protests were heard from most of the military and civilian personnel at the hearing. They supported the highway as proposed. In addition to city and county officials and civic leaders, there were delegations from Havelock and Cherry Point.
