Carteret County's 4-H Clubs have experienced remarkable growth during recent years. According to records there were nine clubs meeting in 1952 with 156 boys and 222 girls for a total of 377 members...

The entire 4-H Program was increased in 1954 as new clubs were organized at several schools. Intermediate clubs were started at Atlantic, Smyrna, Harkers Island and Camp Glenn...

In September 1954 an intermediate club was organized at Newport which brought the total number of clubs in the county to 15. Now there are 408 boys enrolled and 460 girls...

A Community 4-H Club will be organized at Pelletier and the enrollment may easily go over 900. It is the purpose of the extension agents in the county to give every boy and girl in school from 10 years of age up the opportunity and advantage of being a 4-H club member...

The largest 4-H Club in the county is the Camp Glenn Junior Club with 103 members. There are 74 members in the Harkers Island Junior Club, 93 in the Smyrna Junior Club and 79 in the Newport Junior Club...

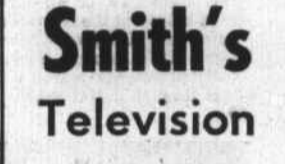
