 Ocracoke — Many people who come to Ocracoke Island are so charmed by its unique atmosphere and exciting history that they immediately decide to write a book about it. But few get around to it.

However, Fran Martin, Norfolk's author of children's books, came to the island two summers ago for several weeks, caught the inspiration to write about Ocracoke, and did so.

Her book, Pirate Island, will be published by Harper's this fall and will especially delight children living on the Outer Banks or in Eastern North Carolina.

Since the hero of the tale is a young boy of the period and the villain is that famous pirate, Edward Teach, alias Blackbeard, the book may have more appeal to 12-year-old boys than to the less venturesome young ladies of 12 years.

In addition to picturing the actual capture of Blackbeard in 1718 by Lt. Robert Maynard of the Royal Navy, Mrs. Martin in one chapter deals with the Dismal
