Deaf-Blind Man Builds Home

Drayton Plains, Mich. (AP)—Morris A. Strong, totally deaf since he was 12 and blind for the last 18 years is building his own eight-room home. His wife is his only helper. Strong has done all the electric wiring and plumbing. He did most of the excavating and most of the roofing.

He drives nails, works easily with a shovel and wheelbarrow and, according to Mrs. Strong, "was all over the framework of the house before there was much to walk on."

Besides carpentry Strong makes machine parts on a metalwork lathe and drill press. He weaves rugs, works on the engine of the family car and writes letters to other blind persons all over the world, either on a conventional or Braille typewriter. He also writes for "The Skylark," a magazine for persons who are blind and deaf.

Another project has been a training course in massage reducing methods. This, he hopes, will someday lead to a full time job.
