Official Answers **Questions About Easter Seal Funds**

Crippled children have sent their personal appeals into the homes of county residents, urging friends who may have forgotten them to mail their contributions off before the 1956 campaign closes Tuesday.

With their plea, a statement by Mrs. Zeb Mauney Jr. executive director of the Carteret County Easter Seal Society, answered ques-tions often asked by contributors to the annual campaign.

Q. Who sponsors the Easter Seal

A. The annual Easter Seal appeal is sponsored by the Junior Woman's club of Morehead City. It is one of 1,655 affiliated units of the National Society for Crippled Children and Adults located throughout the United States, Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico. The National Society is the oldest and largest voluntary agency serving the crippled. It was founded in

Q. What is the purpose of the appeal?

A. It secures funds to provide services for crippled children and adults which are not provided by any other organization. The Easter Seal appeal is the only drive in which the society participates. Q. What direct service does the

society provide?

A. Services vary throughout the country, depending upon needs in various localities and upon finan-ces. Your Easter Seal Society in Carteret County provides wheel chairs, purchases braces, pays for hospitalization, speech correction, transportation to and from the hos-pital, direct medical aid, and supports crippled children's camp.

Q. How does the Society deter-mine which children are to be

A. Parents are urged to apply for services for their crippled children whenever they are needed. Other agencies and individuals such as doctors, nurses and clergymen are encouraged to refer crippled children and adults for help


