Highway Commissioner Reports on 1956 Work

Maynard Hicks, second division highway commissioner, this week released a report on the work the second division did during 1956.

The primary highway system in the division was improved by 26.26 miles of widening, resurfacing and new paving.

The county road system throughout the division was renovated by 83 miles of paving, 87.03 miles of widening, and 84.72 miles of stabilization for all-weather driving.

In Carteret County 3.8 miles of county roads were paved by state forces. A total of 3.8 miles of county roads were widened and three bridges were rebuilt.
