COMMERCIAL FISHERIES REGULATIONS

The following regulations were adopted at the January 7-8, 1957, meeting of the Board of Conservation and Development, under and in accordance with the regulatory powers vested by Chapter 113, Section 135 and 136 of the General Statutes of North Carolina in said Board. These regulations have been filed with the Secretary of State of North Carolina, certified copies dispatched by registered mail to the Clerks of the Superior Court of the twenty-one counties having commercial fishing waters and advertised once a week for four weeks as provided by law.
Any violation of these regulations under the provisions of law constitutes a misdemeanor.
"Substitute Regulation No. 62 under Food Fish, on Page 23, of the Commercial Fisheries Rules and Regulations — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to set or fish any dutch net or pound net within one mile of the mouth of any river emptying into Albemarle Sound of less than two miles in width at its mouth.
Provided, however, that it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to set, have set or fish any gill or pound nets or seines in any waters of the State between December 1 and January 1; or to set, fish, or have set any gill nets, pound nets or seines between the 25th day of April and the 1st day of June; provided, however, that in the Chowan River from Tunis to the mouth of said river and in that portion of the Albemarle Sound between the mouth of said river and a line from Batts Island to Laurel Point Lighthouse the above regulations shall not apply and it shall be lawful to set and fish pound nets and to operate seines throughout the year except for the period from April 25 to June 30 of each year; provided further that nothing in this regulation shall apply to pound nets set in the Atlantic Ocean.
"New Regulation No. 16 under Inland Fishing Waters, Page 9 of the Rules and Regulations — The Commercial Fisheries Commissioner and the Director of the Department of Conservation and Development are hereby empowered to restrict the taking of both clams and oysters from any North Carolina

waters suspected of being polluted and dangerous to the public health when so advised by the State Board of Health."
"New Regulation No. 14 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in New River within the following territory: Inside a line beginning at Hall Point and running in a straight line to Poverty Point; thence in a South-easterly direction along the shoreline to the point of beginning."
"New Regulation No. 15 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in New River within the following territory: Within one thousand yards of the earthen dock at the U. S. Marine Corps Rifle Range."
"New Regulation No. 16 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in New River within the following territory: Inside a line beginning on the South side of New River and running due North-west through channel marker No. 27 to the opposite shore; thence in a Northerly direction along the shoreline to the headwaters of New River; thence in a Southerly direction along the Eastern side of New River to the point of beginning, and to include all of the waters of New River and its tributaries upstream from channel marker No. 27."
"New Regulation No. 17 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in Bear Creek in Onslow County within the following territory: Inside a line beginning on the West side of Bear Creek at Intracoastal Waterway channel marker No. 58 and running in a Northeasterly direction across Bear Creek to the point of land; thence in a Northerly direction along the shoreline of Bear Creek to its point of origin; thence in a Southerly direction along the opposite shoreline of Bear Creek to the point of beginning."

"New Regulation No. 16 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in New River within the following territory: Inside a line beginning on the South side of New River and running due North-west through channel marker No. 27 to the opposite shore; thence in a Northerly direction along the shoreline to the headwaters of New River; thence in a Southerly direction along the Eastern side of New River to the point of beginning, and to include all of the waters of New River and its tributaries upstream from channel marker No. 27."
"New Regulation No. 17 under Restricted Territory, Page 39B — It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to take, catch, bed, lay out or float oysters or clams or for any person, firm or corporation to sell, offer for sale or to have in possession any oysters or clams taken, caught, bedded, laid out or floated in Bear Creek in Onslow County within the following territory: Inside a line beginning on the West side of Bear Creek at Intracoastal Waterway channel marker No. 58 and running in a Northeasterly direction across Bear Creek to the point of land; thence in a Northerly direction along the shoreline of Bear Creek to its point of origin; thence in a Southerly direction along the opposite shoreline of Bear Creek to the point of beginning."
