### Mayor Mann Comments On Water Billing Rates

Mayor Leon Mann Jr., Newport, has clarified the town board's recent action regarding water rates. Mayor Mann says the board has not changed the requirement of \$2.50 minimum per month per dwelling unit, that is, a separate apartment, "but rather the billing of water used over the minimum dollar bill. For example, two units using water through one meter with one person responsible for the bill—the minimum bill would be \$5, but the user would be entitled to 5,500 gallons of water, rather than 4,000 as previously."
