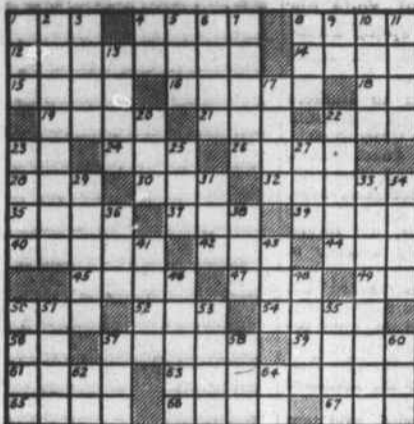

They Came to Cordura Opens at Morehead City

One of the year's most important pictures, starring Gary Cooper, Rita Hayworth, Van Heflin and Tab Hunter, the William Goetz production of *They Came to Cordura*, opens Thursday at the Morehead Theatre.
