Laredo Air Force Base, Texas—Second Lt. Elbert C. Meares, Gloucester, recently received the silver wings and rating of an Air Force pilot in a ceremony conducted at Laredo Air Force Base, Texas.

The graduation marked the culmination of fourteen months of intensive academic and flight training in both conventional and jet aircraft.

Lieutenant Meares received his commission through the AFROTC program, upon graduation from the North Carolina State College of A&E in June 1959.

The 23-year-old pilot is presently assigned to Castle Air Force Base, California, attending flight transition school in the KC-135 jet mid-air refueler.

Mr. and Mrs. William Willis and son, Bill, were dinner guests of her mother and family last Sunday.

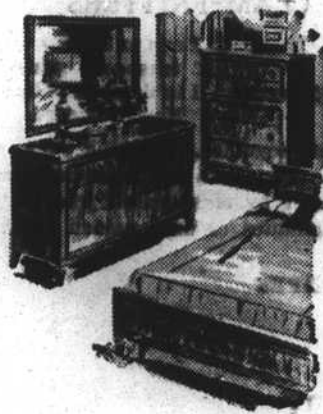
Miss Regina Pake will leave Wednesday to enter college as a freshman at East Carolina.

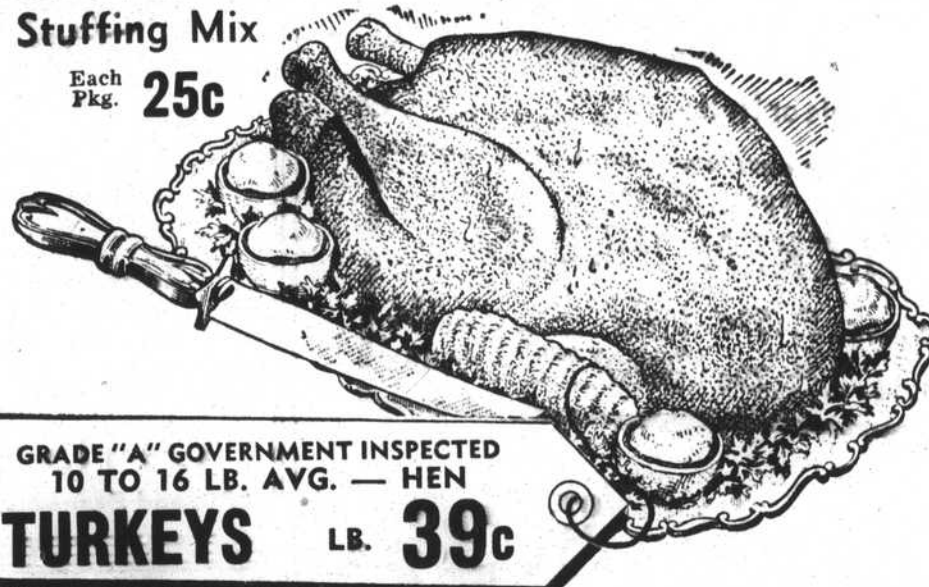

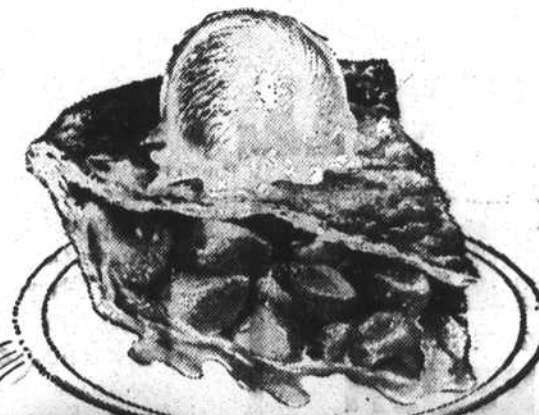
