

Gifts from Kitchen Can Be Frozen Beforehand

I am sure that all of you who have freezers are familiar with the use of aluminum foil (heavy duty) in packing foods for freezing. Why not try freezing gift foods ahead. Gifts of holiday foods, specialties of your kitchen, are appreciated more than anything else you give to friends and relatives during the holidays. Plan to make them in advance, wrap in foil and freeze. Good foods to freeze are cookies, cakes, fancy breads and rolls, mince and pumpkin pics, chiffon

Several hours before giving, re-

move the packaged gift foods from freezer and defrost. leaving the wrappings in place. If moisture accumulates on foil during defrosting, pat dry with a towel; then tie Floy G. Garner with gay rib-



Here are recipes for two excellent "Prepare Ahead and Freeze"

gift foods: Ground Hazel Nut Loaf Cake 1/2 cups sifted cake flour teaspoon baking powder ½ teaspoon salt

½ cup butter or margarine % cup sugar 1/3 cup milk

1/2 cup ground hazel nuts, hickory nuts or pecans

Sift flour and measure; add baking powder and salt and sift again. 


