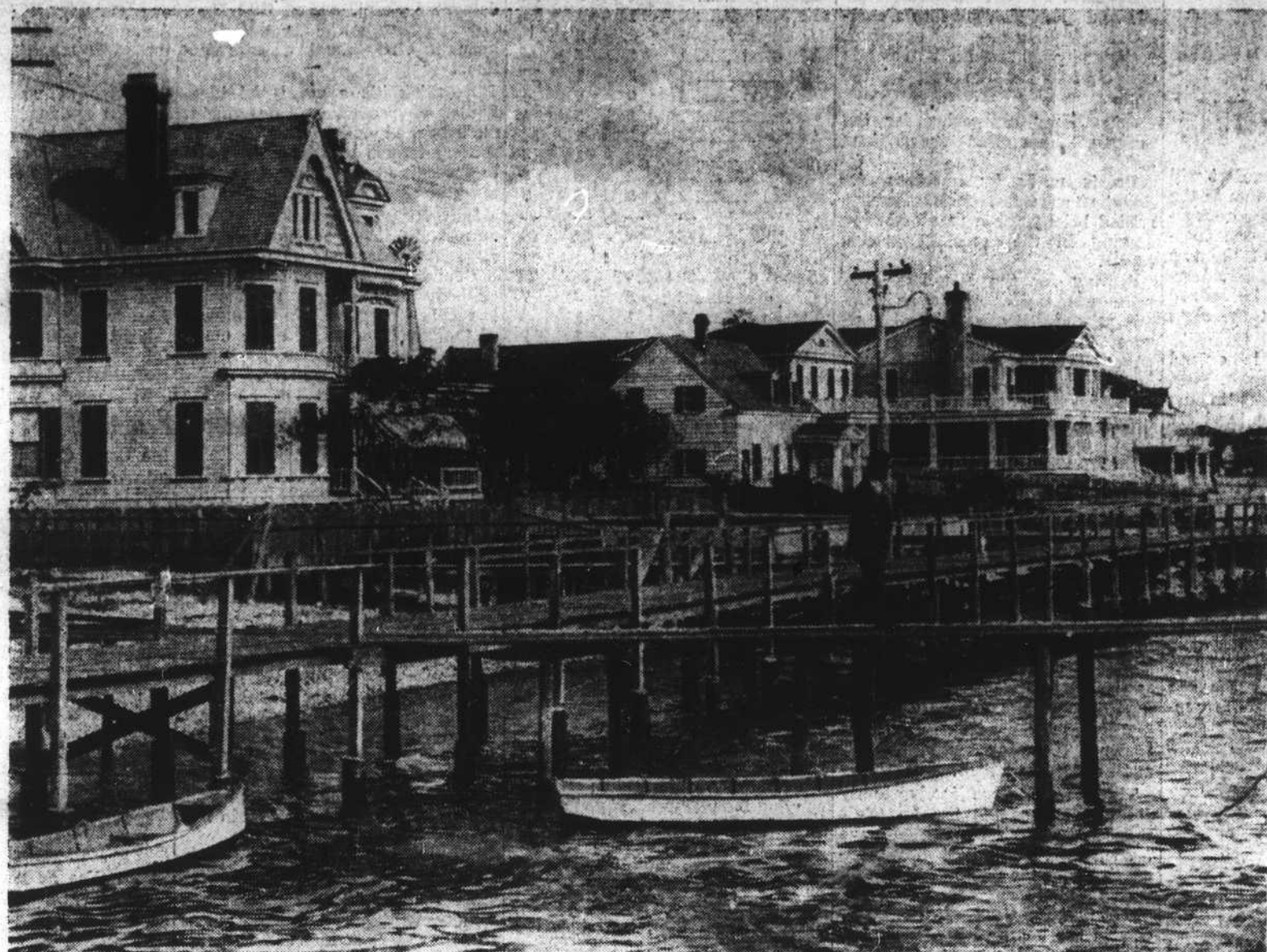


1912 - From Ox Carts to Jets - 1962



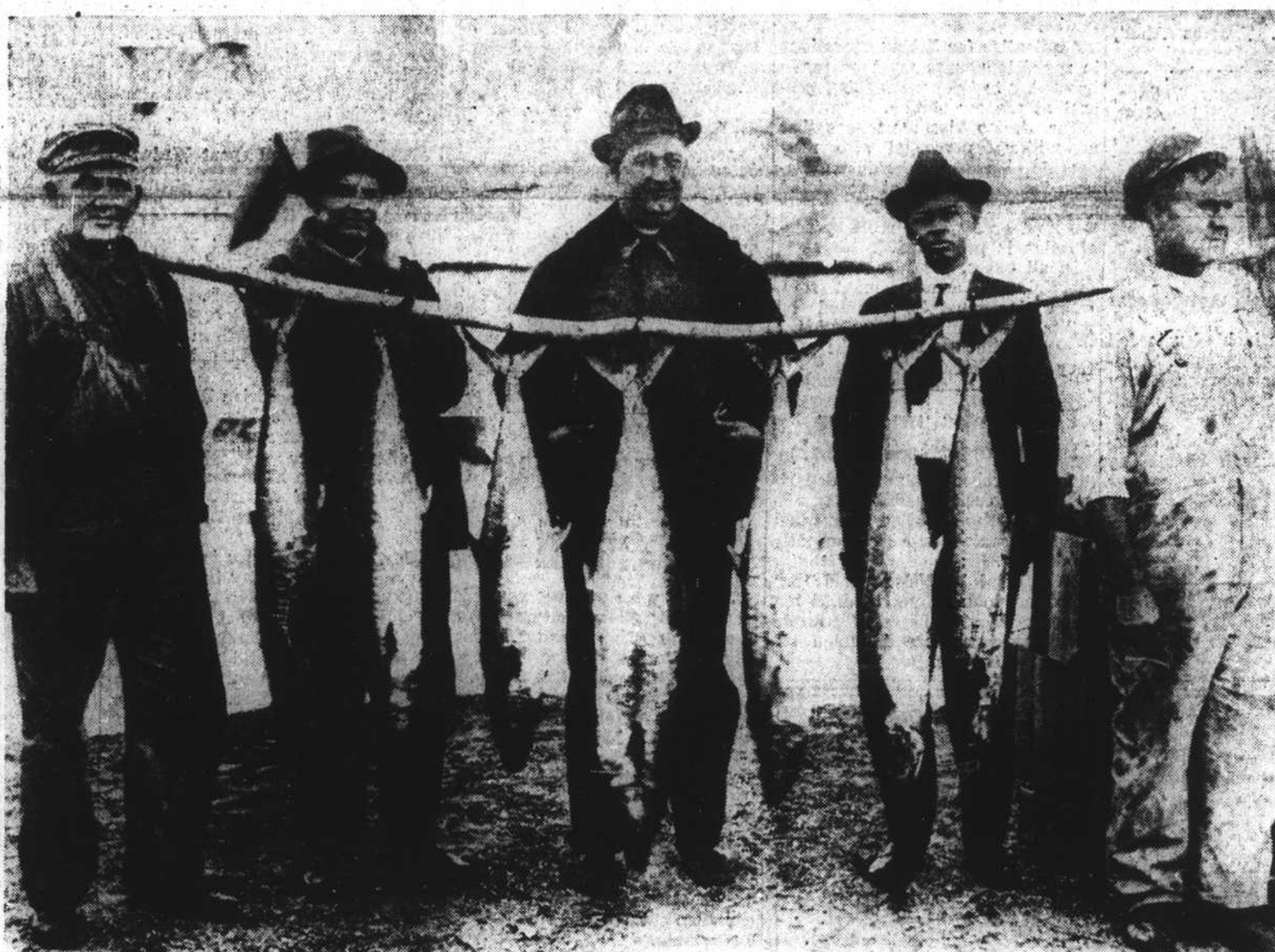
In 1912, the boardwalk along Beaufort's waterfront had only five more years of existence. It went when the seawall came.



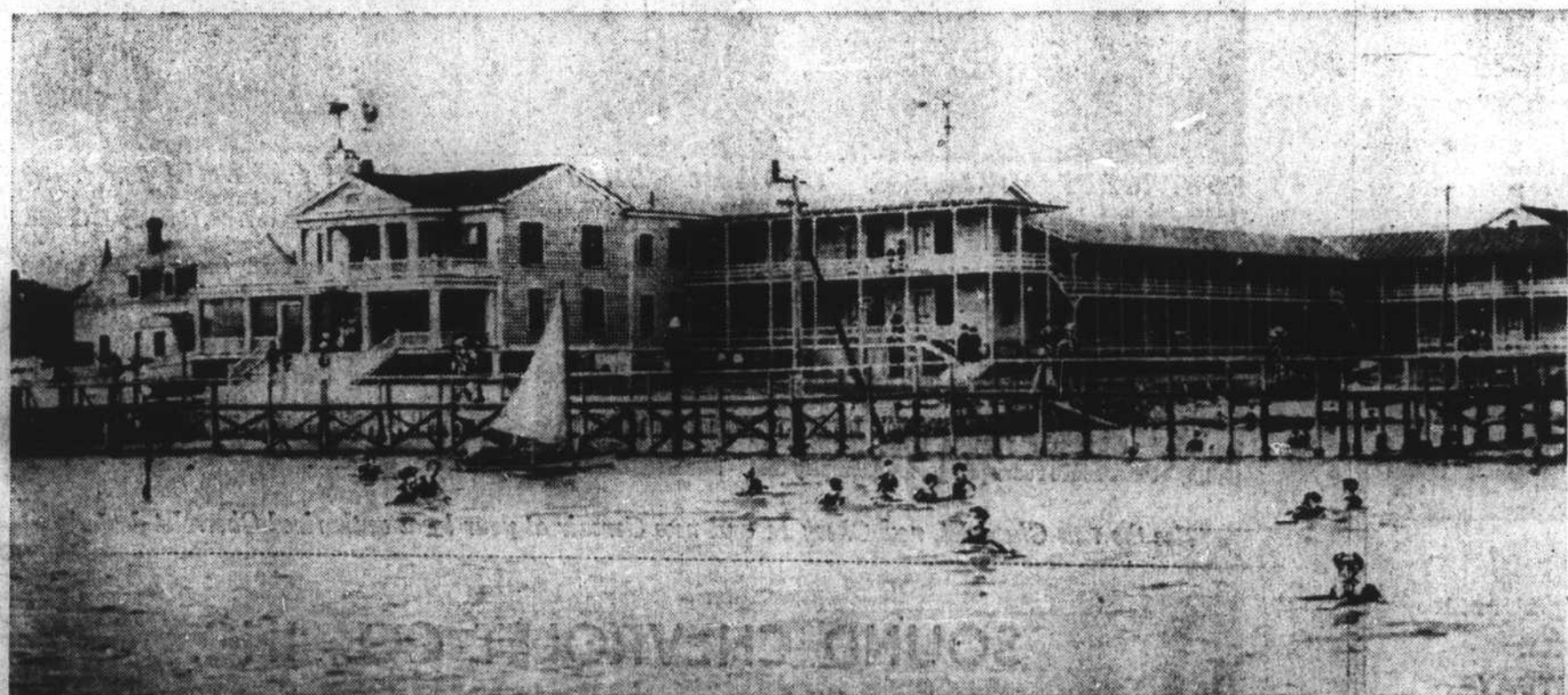

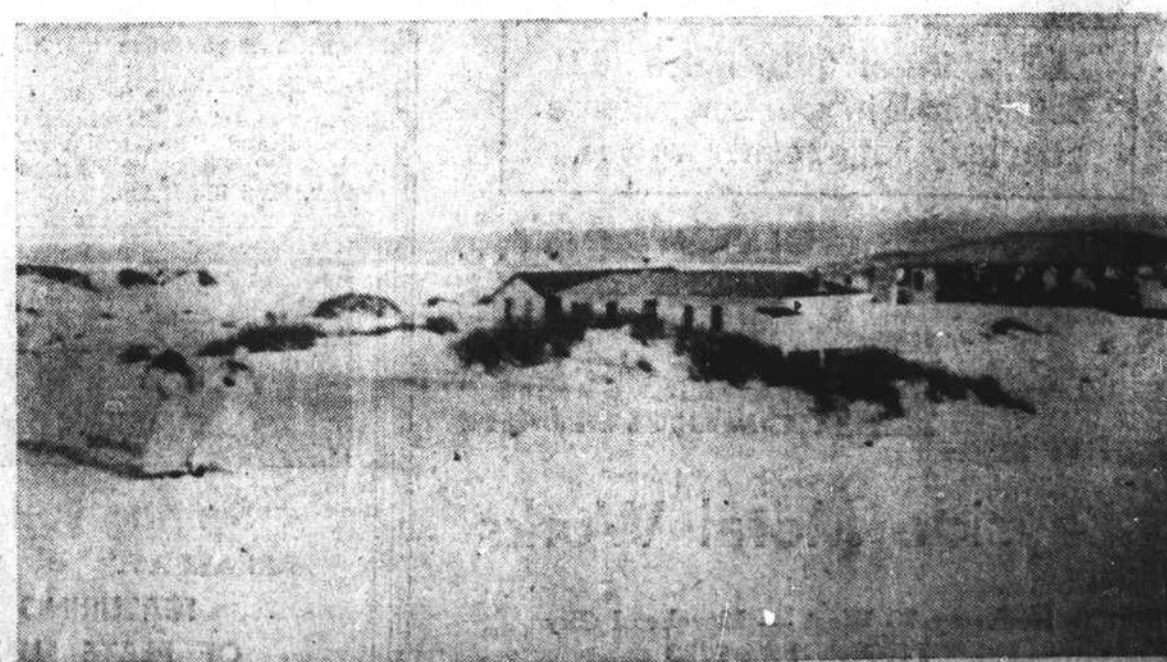
Four-year-old Aleasc Turnage, Beaufort, sports beaver hat.
