DOMESTIC PULPWOOD RECEIPTS DOWN Domestic pulpwood receipts by U. S. mills in January, amounting to 1,182,867 cords, were 26,533 cords below receipts obtained in January 1945, according to the latest monthly report on pulpwood receipts just issued by the Bureau of Census of the U. S. Department of Commerce.

Increased imports in January of this year, however, helped to bring a total pulpwood receipts by all mills up to 1,335,886 cords for the month, an increase of 29,286 cords over receipts in the same month of the preceding year. January 1946 imports were given by the Census Bureau as 153,019 cords.

Domestic receipts in the Appalachian region in January of this year were placed at 77,897 cords in the Commerce report. These receipts bettered those received in the previous January by 4,897 cords.
