**Health Department News**

The District Health Department announces that Dr. E. T. Koonce, dentist for the State Board of Health, will begin the dental program in Yancey county on August 5, 1946. This is one week before schools open (August 12). It has been decided that Dr. Koonce will spend the first week in Burnsville school.

The Health Department and the Supt. of county schools request that the children who will attend Burnsville grade school will come to the school house on Monday morning August 5, in order to make an appointment with Dr. Koonce for work to be done during the week. It is asked that the children do not stay away on the first day, thinking others will come and crowd the schedule. All should come in order that Dr. Koonce will be able to make a schedule for the entire week, giving the day and hour for the children to return.

Dr. Koonce spent some time in the Burnsville school last year, and of course will be unable to work in all the schools. For that reason, most of his time will be spent in other schools of the county. It is hoped that he will be able to spend twelve weeks in Yancey county schools and the same time in Avery

County. Mitchell county has not yet entered the dental program, but is expected to do so before August 1.

Dr. Koonce completes the work for children whose parents are unable to pay for such work. He usually cleans the teeth of all children and advises them what work is needed, and of the necessity of regular visits to private dentists. If you are able to pay your private dentist, do not hesitate to send your children to the Burnsville clinic, because although he will not complete their work, he will refer them to their private dentist.

Frequently, cavities develop that you are unable to discover yourself. Dr. Koonce will make these examinations and advise just what work needs to be done.
