FOREST FIRES

During February 1947 District One, of the North Carolina Forest Service had 24 forest fires which burned a total of 212.5 acres of privately owned forest land in the 6 counties under forest fire control in this district.

Of these 24 fires, in February, the responsible party was established on 12 of them, and reprimanded: During February, 2 persons were prosecuted; 1 for burning without a permit and 1 for burning without a permit and allowing fire to escape.

During the remaining months of the spring fire season, the public is urged to be careful with fire. To secure a permit when burning and follow closely the instructions which are received with it in order to burn safely.

In the spring a burning permit is required by law from the 1st day of February to the first day of June inclusive.
