I wish to advise all my friends and supporters that I resigned as Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Yancey County on September 2, 1947, because I could not work in harmony with the other members of the Board of Commissioners.

I wish to thank the many friends who supported me in the General Election of November, 1946, and to advise the people of Yancey county that during the nine months time from the first Monday in December, 1946, when I took office as Chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Yancey county until my resignation on September 2, 1947, Yancey county paid all its current obligations and reduced the bonded indebtedness of the county in the sum of \$8,000.00. At the time of my resignation on September 2, 1947, Yancey county had the sum of \$14,000.00 in the debt fund
