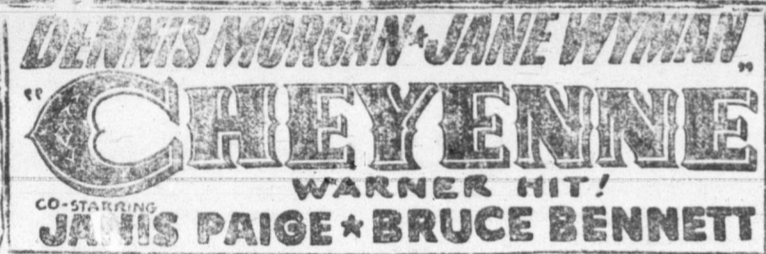

STATE'S FARM INCOME DROPS NINE MILLION

North Carolina is one of only four states in the nation whose cash receipts from farm marketing showed a decrease during 1947.

Although receipts for the nation as a whole rose 23 per cent, the farm income in North Carolina showed a decrease of \$9,200,000. Only other states showing a decrease were Delaware, South Carolina, and Florida. Receipts from North Carolina crops during 1947 were \$32,100,000 less, primarily caused by lower prices for tobacco; but receipts from livestock and livestock products increased \$22,500,000.

Benefit payments under the Old Age and Survivors Insurance provisions of the Social Security Act are not automatic, but must be applied for by the persons eligible — wage earners, widows, children, dependent parents, and others defined by the law.

Every employer of one or more persons, part-time or full time, should apply for an employer's number under the Social Security Act, unless specifically exempt.
