

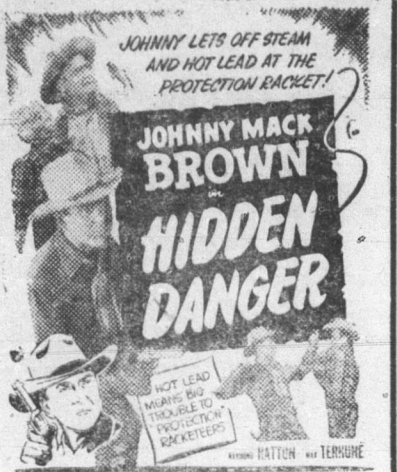

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Education of Yancey County, at the Court House, Burnsville, N. C., until 11:00 o'clock A. M. E. S. T., April 12th, 1950 and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read, in the Court Room of the Yancey County Court House, Burnsville, N. C., for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the reconstruction of the Bee Log School Building and appurtenances thereto. Proposals received after the hour and date specified above will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received for the General Contract and the Electrical Contract. Complete plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available for inspection at the office of the Owner, and in the office of the Architect, Lindsey M. Gudger, 52 Carter Street, Asheville, N. C. after March 15th, 1950. Plans, specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained by prime contractors upon deposit of \$30.00 in cash or check, for General Contract; \$30.00 in cash or check for Electrical Contract. The full deposit will be returned to contractors submitting bona fide proposals, provided plans and specifications are returned to the Architect in good condition within ten days after the date set for receiving of bids. Subcontractor's deposits will be refunded less cost of printing and handling.

All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, or by a certified check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5% of the proposal; or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a Certified Check of 2% of the bid plus a bid bond of 3% of the bid; said deposit to be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.
