T., April 12th, 1950 and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read, in the Court Room of the Yancey County Court House, Burnsville, N. C., for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the reconstruction of the Bee Log School Building and appurtenances thereto.

Separate bids will be received for the General Contract and the Electrical Contract.

Complete plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available for inspection at the office of the Owner, and in the office of the Architect, Lindsey M. Guder, 52 Carter Street, Asheville, N. C. after March 15th, 1950. Plans, specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained by prime contractors upon deposit of \$30.00 in cash or check for General Contract; \$30.00 in cash or check for Electrical Contract.

All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, or by a certified check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5% of the proposal; or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a Certified Check of 2% of the bid plus a bid bond of 3% of the bid; said deposit to be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law.

Performance Bond will be required in amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

Payment will be made on the basis of ninety percent (90%) of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of thirty days.

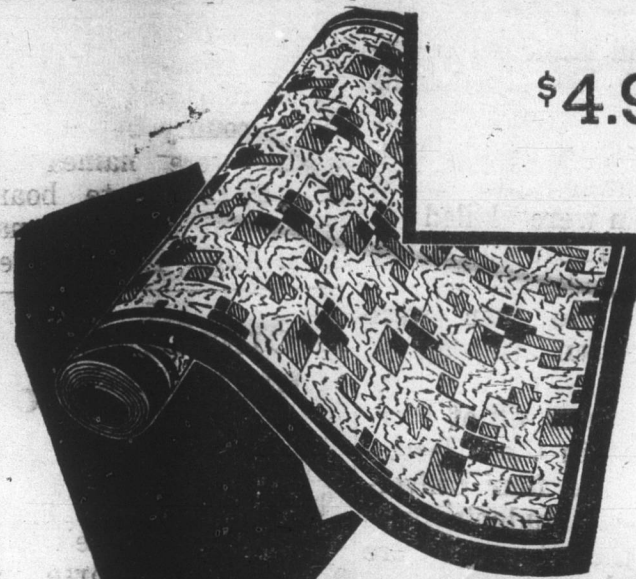

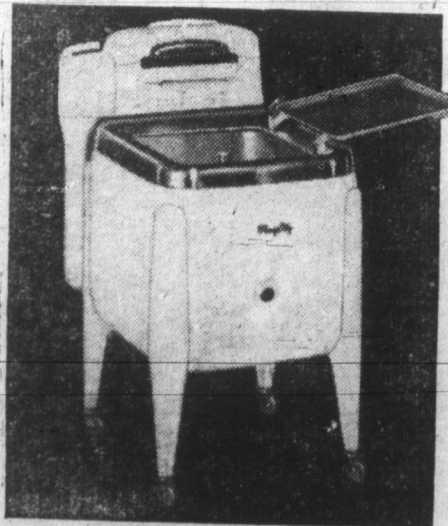
