Army and Air Force Open For Unlimited Enlistments

T. Sgt. Harry V. Belt of the Army and Air Force Recruiting officer in Asheville has announced that he and M. Sgt. Stanley W. Wapinski will be at the Courthouse in Burnsville each Monday to accept enlistments for these two military services.

Any person between 17 and 34 can apply for enlistment in the Army or Air Force subject to whatever regulations are in effect at the time of applying. Further information in this respect can be secured by contacting Sgt. Wapinski or Sgt. Belt.

At the present time the Army has open the following branches for direct enlistment: Infantry, Field Artillery, Coast Artillery, Armored Command, Engineers or regular Army-unassigned. If a man is interested in the Air Force he will be enlisted for Air Force unassigned.

Sgt. Belt stated that all men accepted in Burnsville are first sent to Charlotte for further screening and if successful in passing there, the men going in the army will be sent to Fort Knox for further training and those going in the air force will go to San Antonio, Texas.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Education of Yancey County, at the Court House, Burnsville, N. C., until 11:00 o'clock A. M. E. S. T., April 12th, 1950 and immediately thereafter publicly opened and read, in the Court Room of the Yancey County Court House, Burnsville, N. C., for the furnishing of labor, materials and equipment entering into the reconstruction of the Bee Log School Building and appurtenances thereto. Proposals received after the hour and date specified above will not be considered.

Separate bids will be received for the General Contract and the Electrical Contract.

Complete plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available for inspection at the office of the Owner, and in the office of the Architect, Lindsey M. Gudger, 52 Carter Street, Asheville, N. C. after March 15th, 1950. Plans, specifications, and other contract documents may be obtained by prime contractors upon deposit of \$30.00 in cash or check, for General Contract; \$30.00 in cash or check for Electrical Contract. The full deposit will be returned to contractors submitting bona fide proposals, provided plans and specifications are returned to the Architect in good condition within ten days after the date set for receiving of bids. Subcontractor's deposits will be refunded less cost of printing and handling.

All Contractors are hereby notified that they must have proper license under the State laws governing their respective trades.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, or by a certified check drawn on and certified by some bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, in an amount equal to not less than 5% of the proposal; or in lieu thereof a bidder may offer a Certified Check of 2% of the bid plus a bid bond of 3% of the bid; said deposit to be retained by the Owner as liquidated damages in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within ten days after the award, or to give satisfactory surety as required by law. Performance Bond will be required in amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

Payment will be made on the basis of ninety percent (90%) of monthly estimates and final payment made upon completion and acceptance of the work.


