

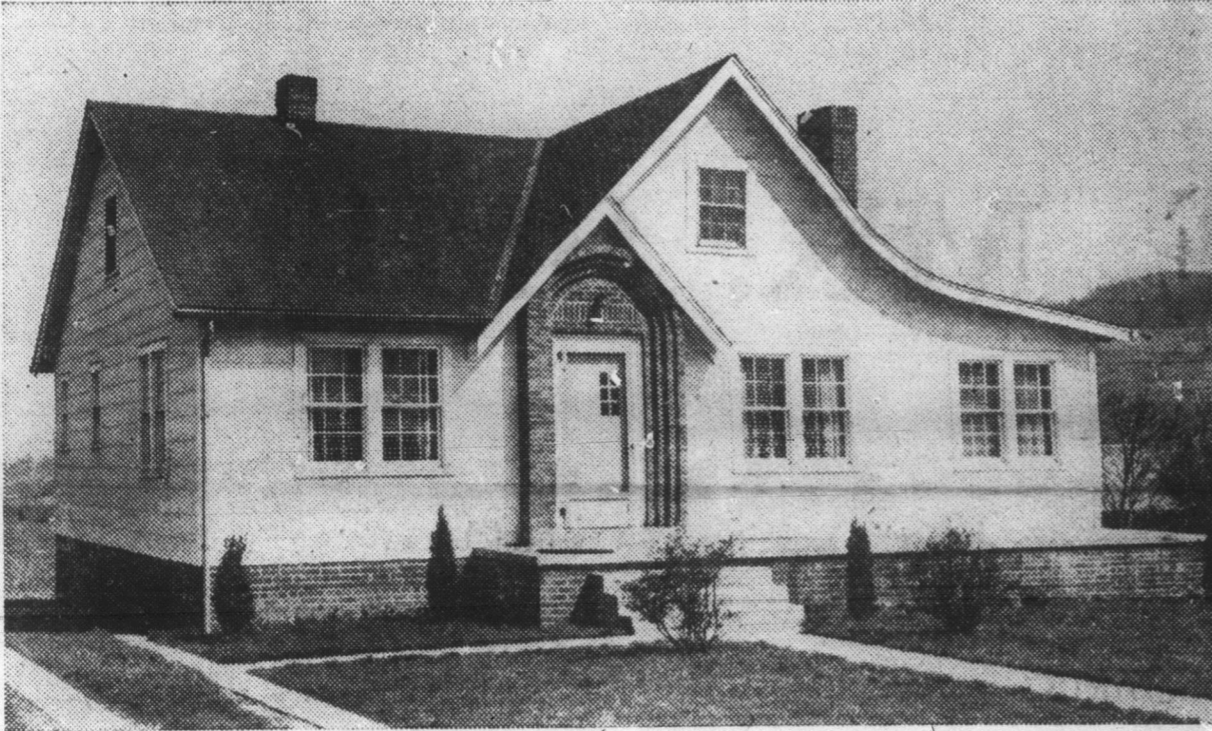

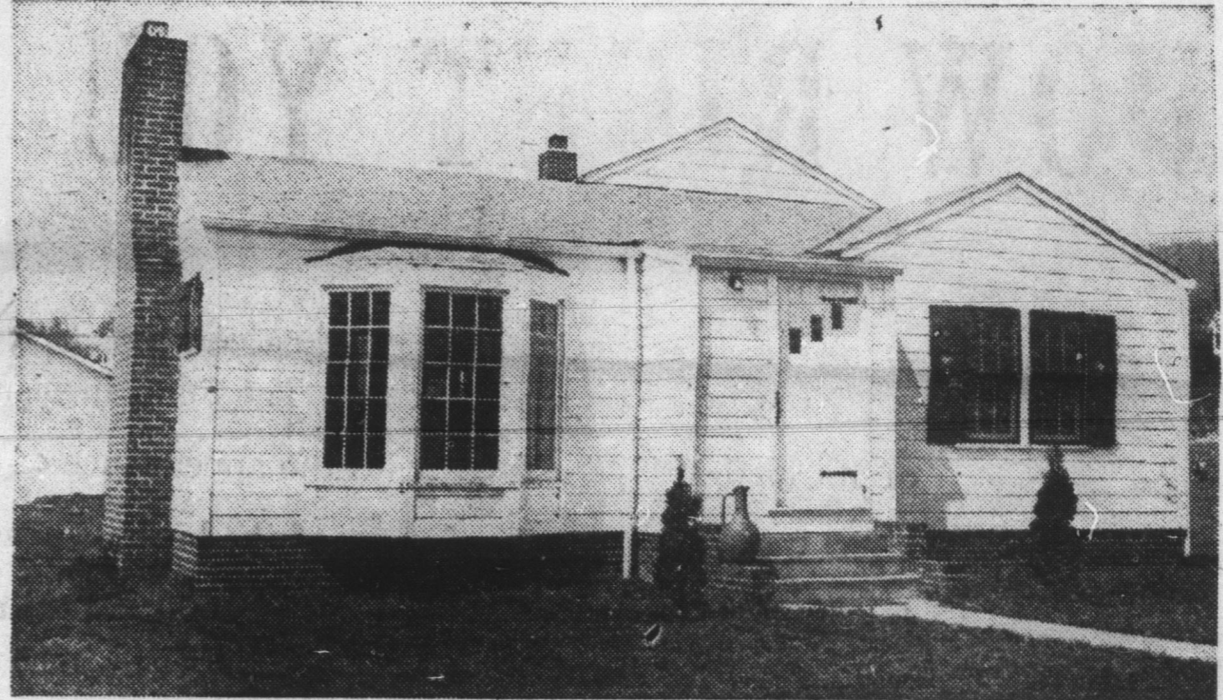

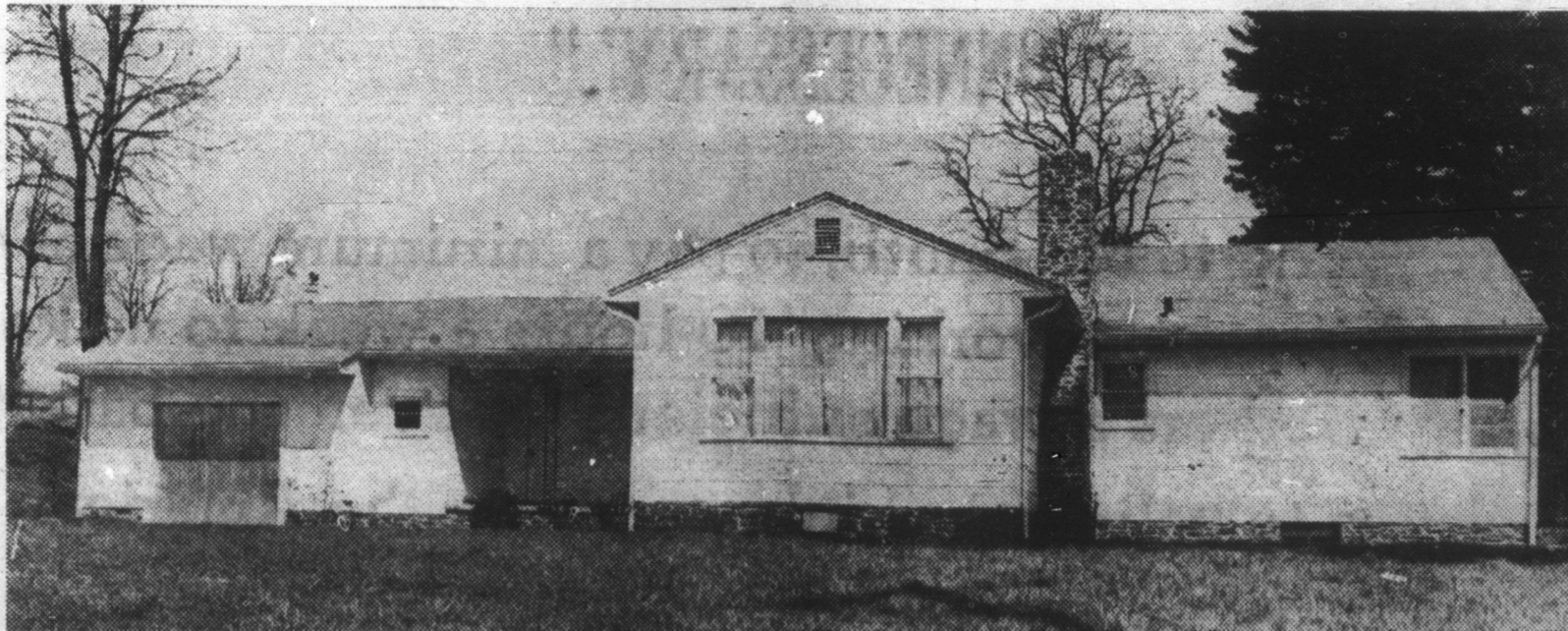
Home of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Riddle in West Burnsville. It is of asbestos siding and of story and half construction, built in 1946
