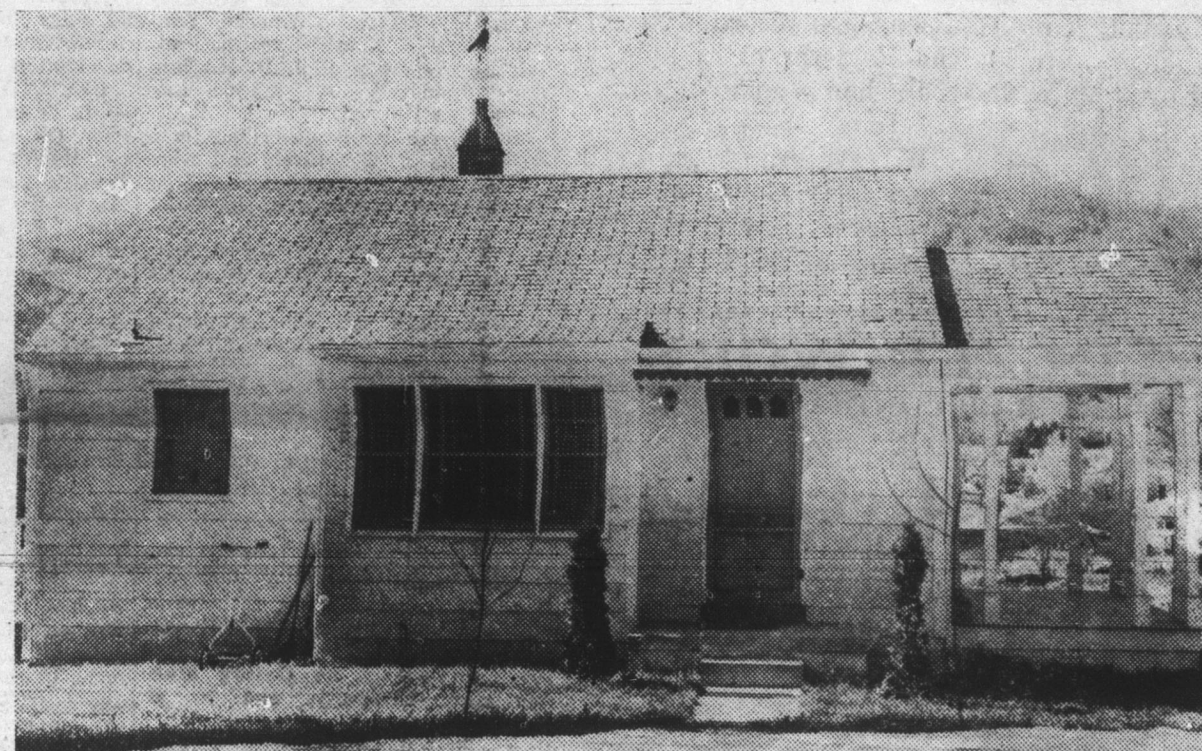
Home of Mr. and Mrs. Guss Peterson, completed this year. It is of brick construction and is located near the school.



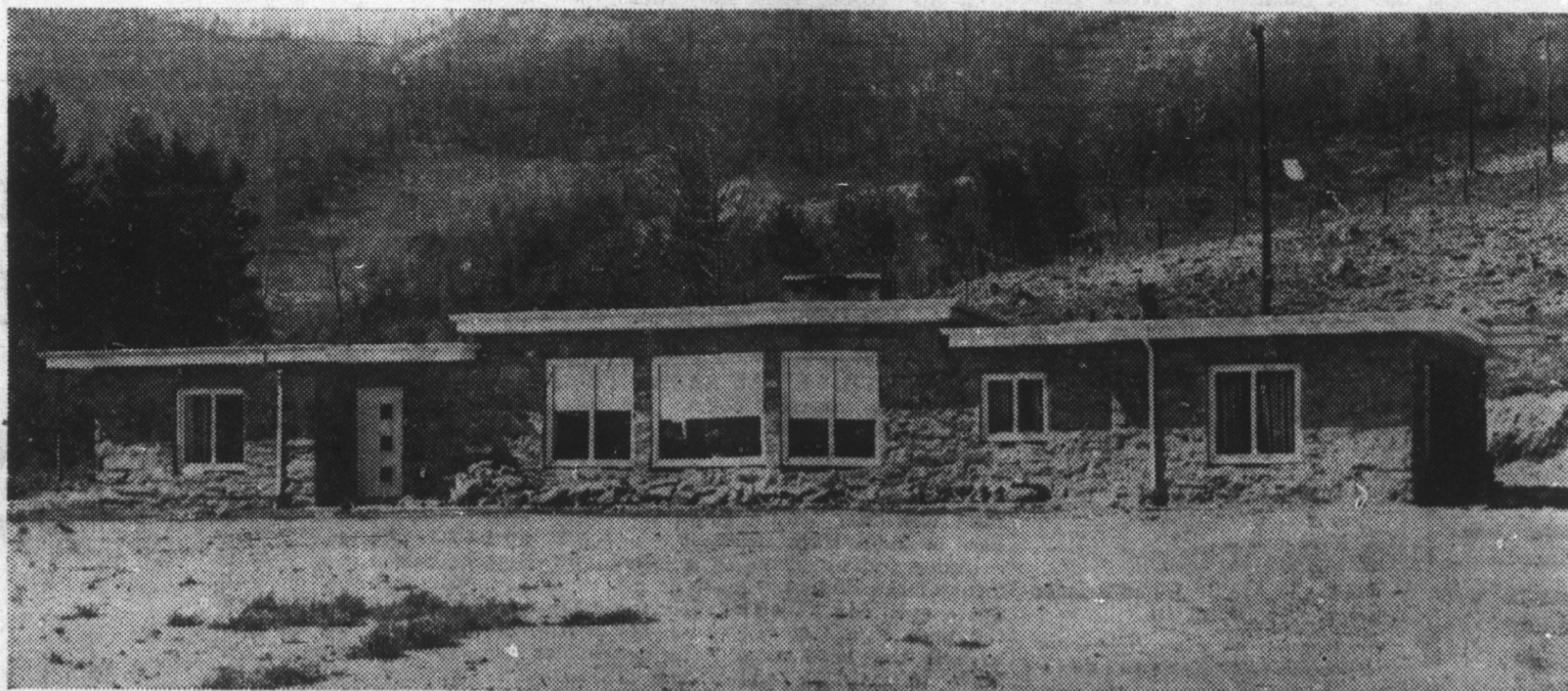
Home of Mr. and Mrs. A. G. Edge, just off Main Street on the Pensacola Highway. It is of brick construction, built in 1948.
