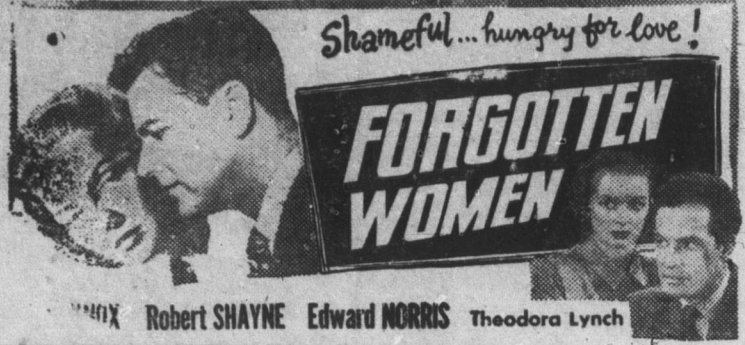

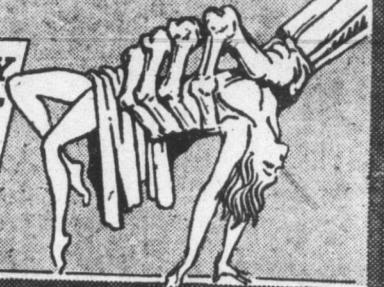

You have fought a good fight, you have run a good race,

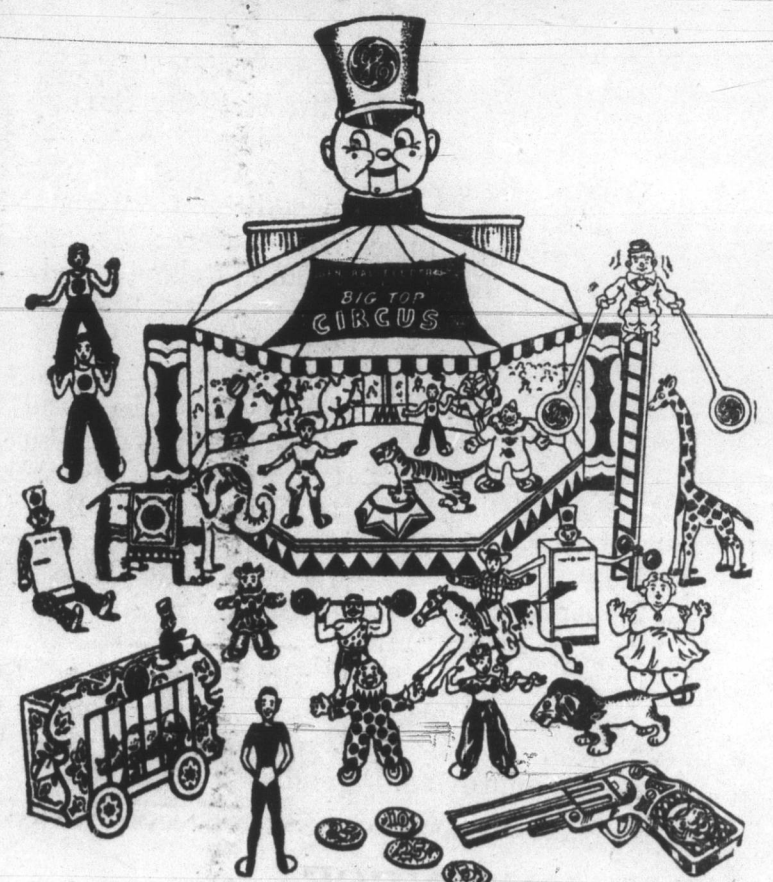
And we hope soon to see you face to face.

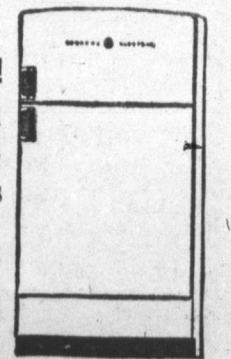
