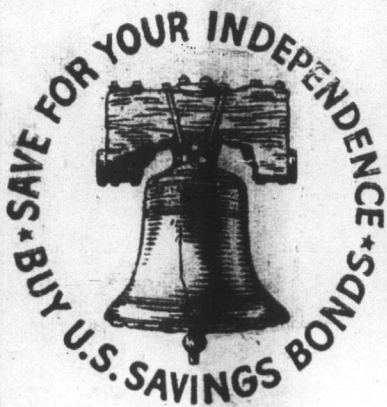

Army Enlistments

Regular Army enlistments for attendance at specific army schools are now open to high school graduates, according to Sgt. John A. Fisher, USA & USAF recruiting Sgt. for Burnsville. New regulations recently released by the department of the Army have opened more than 20 army schools to qualified high school graduates now enlisting in the regular army. Under the new plan, Sgt. Fisher explained, men accepted for attendance at prescribed army schools may select the type of training they desire. Among courses available to graduates under this program are automotive body repair, electricity, tailoring, electric and acetylene welding, railway bridge construction and repair, power equipment maintenance, ship fitting and hospital technician procedure. Complete details concerning the new army plan for high school graduates may be obtained by seeing Sgt. Fisher at the Courthouse in Burnsville any Monday, or by writing him at the USA & USAF Recruiting Station, Post Office Building, Asheville.

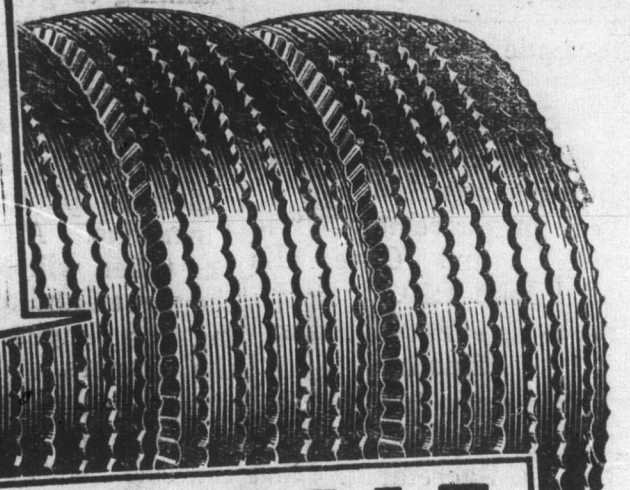

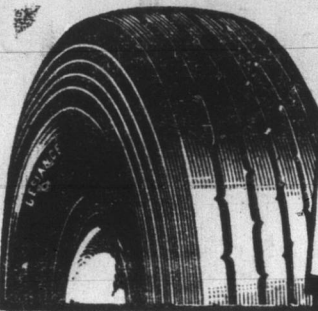
